

Law, Technology and Society Program Film Screening 70 Acres In Chicago: Cabrini Green

Co-sponsored by the Albert Dorman Honors College and the Law, Technology and Society program at NJIT, this film documents the demolition of Chicago's infamous Cabrini Green public housing development. With its prime central location, Cabrini was hailed as a public housing triumph and demonized as an urban disaster. Beginning in 1995, it was demolished and then repackaged as a mixed income development, where, unsurprisingly, the former, largely black residents were marginalized or driven away. *70 Acres* documents this upheaval, from the razing of the first buildings in 1995 to the clashes in the mixed income neighborhoods a decade later.
