BEYOND THE CLASSROOM ASSIGNMENT

The objective of this assignment is to familiarize yourself with the Honors College colloquia offered this semester and to extend your learning experiences beyond the classroom structure.

The Albert Dorman Colloquium Series focuses on the interface between Science, Technology and Society. They feature talks by - and conversations with - industry, academic, and government leaders on a wide range of topics. Field trips to corporate, scientific, cultural, and community organizations are also included during the spring semester. In addition, some important campus political and cultural events are co-sponsored by the Honors College and regarded as part of the Colloquium series.

Honors students must attend a minimum of 2 colloquia each semester and are strongly encouraged to attend more than the required number of colloquia.

Your assignment is to attend at least one colloquium by November 15th, 2016 and submit a review (no more than two pages in length) of the colloquium you attended.

Your review should include the following points:

- a) why you think Honors colloquia are included in the Honors College requirements
- b) the reason you chose to attend this colloquium
- c) a brief paragraph what the colloquium speaker addressed in the presentation
- d) state what you learned about the topic
- e) the relevance and/or impact of the topic on global issues

Remember to include the title of the colloquium you attended at the top of the page along with your name.
